OPERATION PROJECT HOPE LEADERSHIP ACADEMY (OPHLA)

What is the Leadership Academy?

OPHLA is a 4-month program designed to develop leaders, empowered by their wholeness to make a difference in their own lives, the lives of others, their community and the world. The objective is to build on the OPH legacy through empowering leaders to expand and enhance the overall service to the organization. **OPHLA** fills the gap where other leadership trainings fall short. The Pillars of Leadership that are stressed, allows participants to look at both “doing” and “being.”

General Overview

The sessions serve participants in exploring their limiting beliefs about themselves, other people and the world, while being supported by their team, coaches, advisors and mentors. Themes explored include: leadership, commitment and service; empowerment, support and contribution; mastermind, synergy and communication; mindset, programs and beliefs; and value, essence and truth.

Eligibility Requirements

Class size will be limited to 12 participants.

To participate in the Leadership Academy, an applicant must:

1. Submit an application no later Friday, January 13, 2017 info@OperationProjectHOPE.org.
2. Commit to attending the entire series of classes and prep. Meetings (barring an emergency). Dates and applications to be provided at information session.
3. Commit to making all coach and buddy calls.
4. In exchange for 100% subsidized tuition, valued at \$3,500, assume a leadership position on the planning team for the 2017 beautification project. Opportunities include: outreach, administration, operations, fundraising & logistics.
